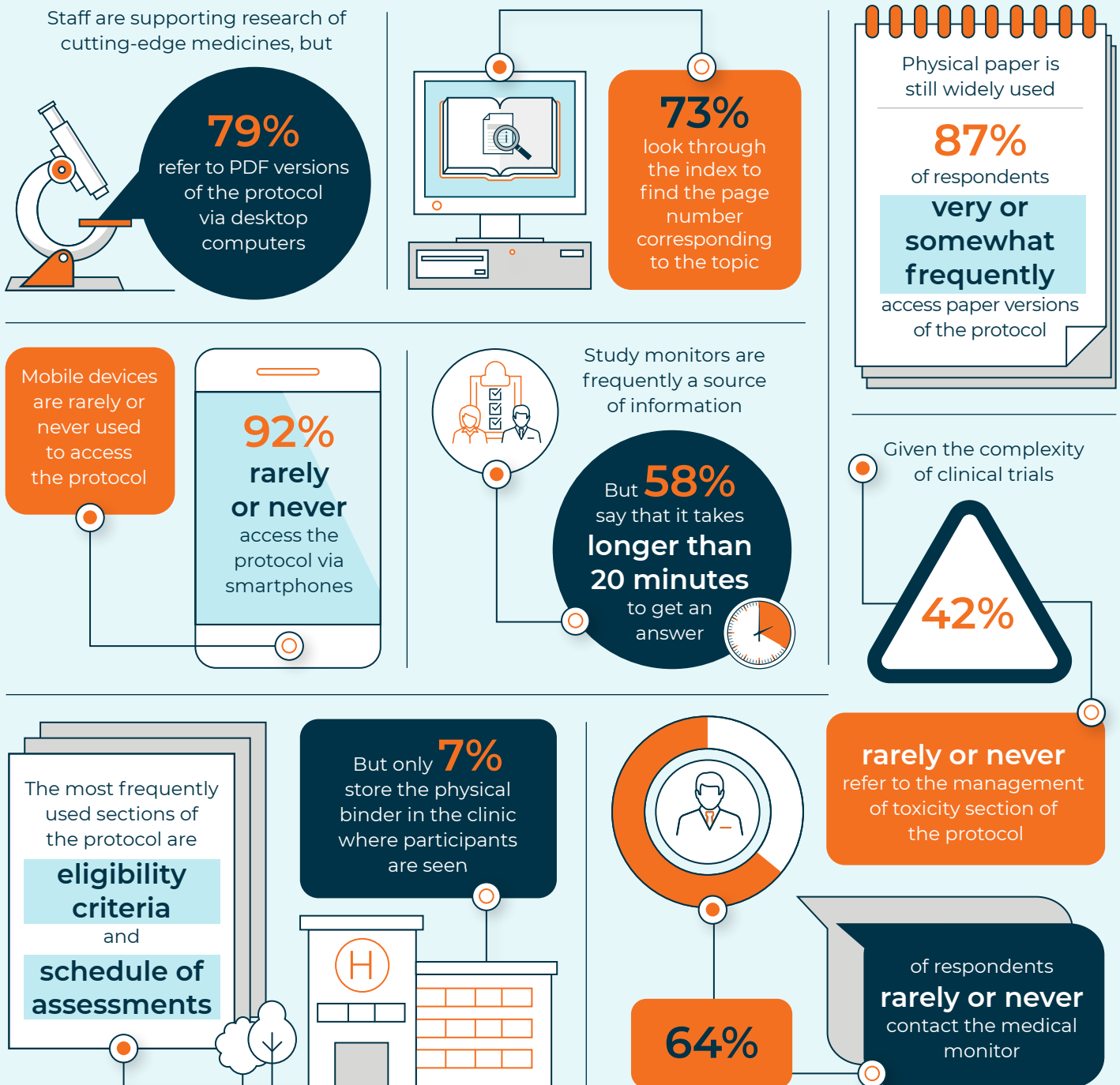


The Digital Paradox: Research Staff and the Clinical Trial Protocol

In a collaborative research project conducted by the Tufts Center for the Study of Drug Development and Teckro, 228 investigative site personnel gave feedback into how they interact with the protocol during the administration of clinical trials. The results suggest a paradox between typical practices and the availability of dynamic digital solutions to optimize protocol instructions.



Today, the protocol is mainly accessed as a static resource. But when the protocol is mobile, digital, and always accessible, it can provide immediate, real-time answers and essential study guidance.
